Fort Qu'Appelle is located 80 kilometers east of Regina in the beautiful Qu'Appelle Valley.

Valley Ambulance Care Ltd is a rural service established in 1989. At present, the service employs ACP's, ICP's, and PCP's. Operations consist of two units that provide 24-7 service. Annual call volume has exceeded 1,500 calls a year. We provide emergency medical services to the communities of Fort Qu'Appelle, Lipton, and Lebret, and surrounding municipalities, as well as, the Resort Villages of B-Say-Tah, Fort San, Sandy Beach, and Katepwa and First Nation's – Standing Buffalo, Pasqua, Piapot and Muscowpetung. The service also provides back up and ALS intercept service to neighboring EMS services, as required.

The community of Fort Qu'Appelle boasts many amenities: Mission Ridge Ski Park, Echo Ridge Golf Course, beaches, recreational center, education (K-12), RCMP, Hospital, Volunteer Fire Department, shopping, restaurants, Treaty 4 Governance Centre, curling rink, snowmobile trails, golf course, fishing and camping.

The service is, at present, contracted to the Saskatchewan Health Authority, previously the Regina Qu'Appelle Health Region. The successful applicant will provide a combination of regular worked hours, on call hours, and overtime. Shifts are 24 hours shared between primary and secondary coverage as per Saskatchewan Health's contractual obligations.
