About North-East EMS and Nipawin

North-East EMS has the largest coverage area in Saskatchewan, covering more than 25,000 square kms. We respond to a variety of emergent and non-emergent calls totalling to about 2100 calls annually. We work out of 3 bases. The main base is in Nipawin with 4 ambulances and two 4x4 rover trucks. Carrot River (40 km East of Nipawin) has a full crew stationed there 24/7. Our 3rd base is in Cumberland House and has an ACP and PCP stationed there 24/7 as well.

Nipawin is located about 250 kms northeast of Saskatoon. It rests on the shores of Tobin and Codette Lakes and is a popular destination for recreation. Tobin Lake is known for its trophy fishing and many fishing derbies. Hunting, snowmobiling and golf are common recreational past times.
